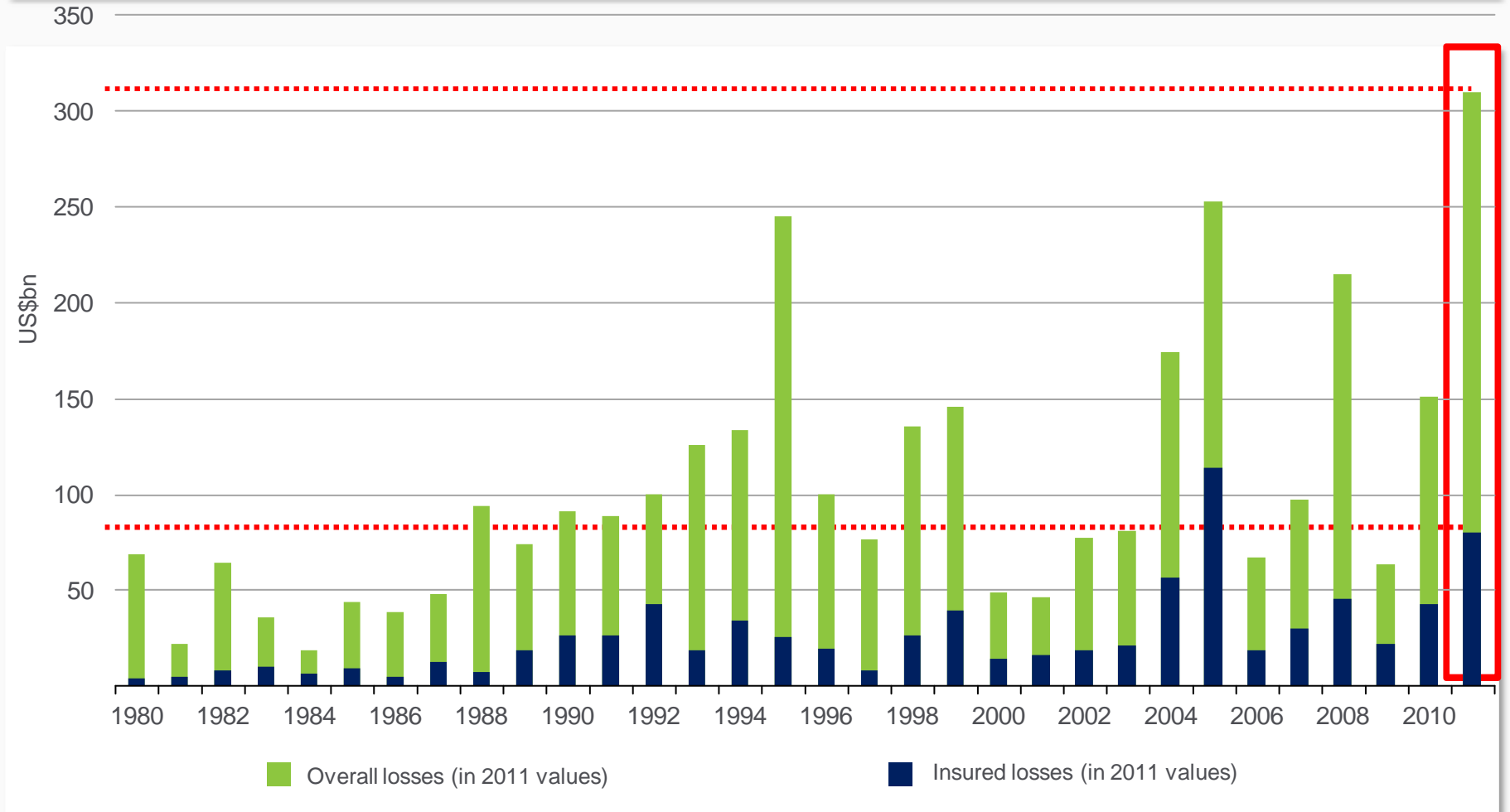

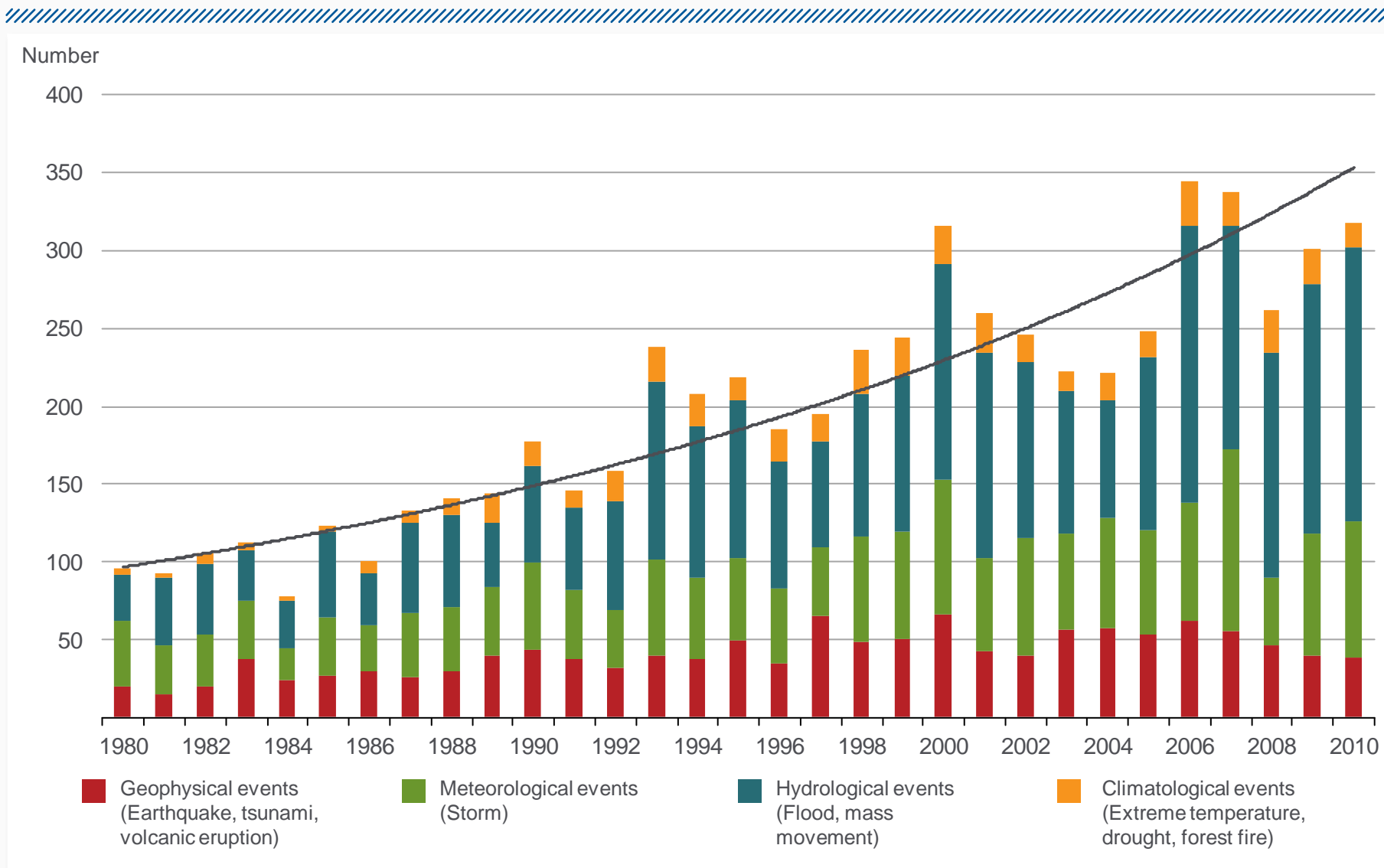
Overall and Insured Losses

Losses in 2011 (January – September): Overall = US\$ 310bn; Insured = US\$ 80bn



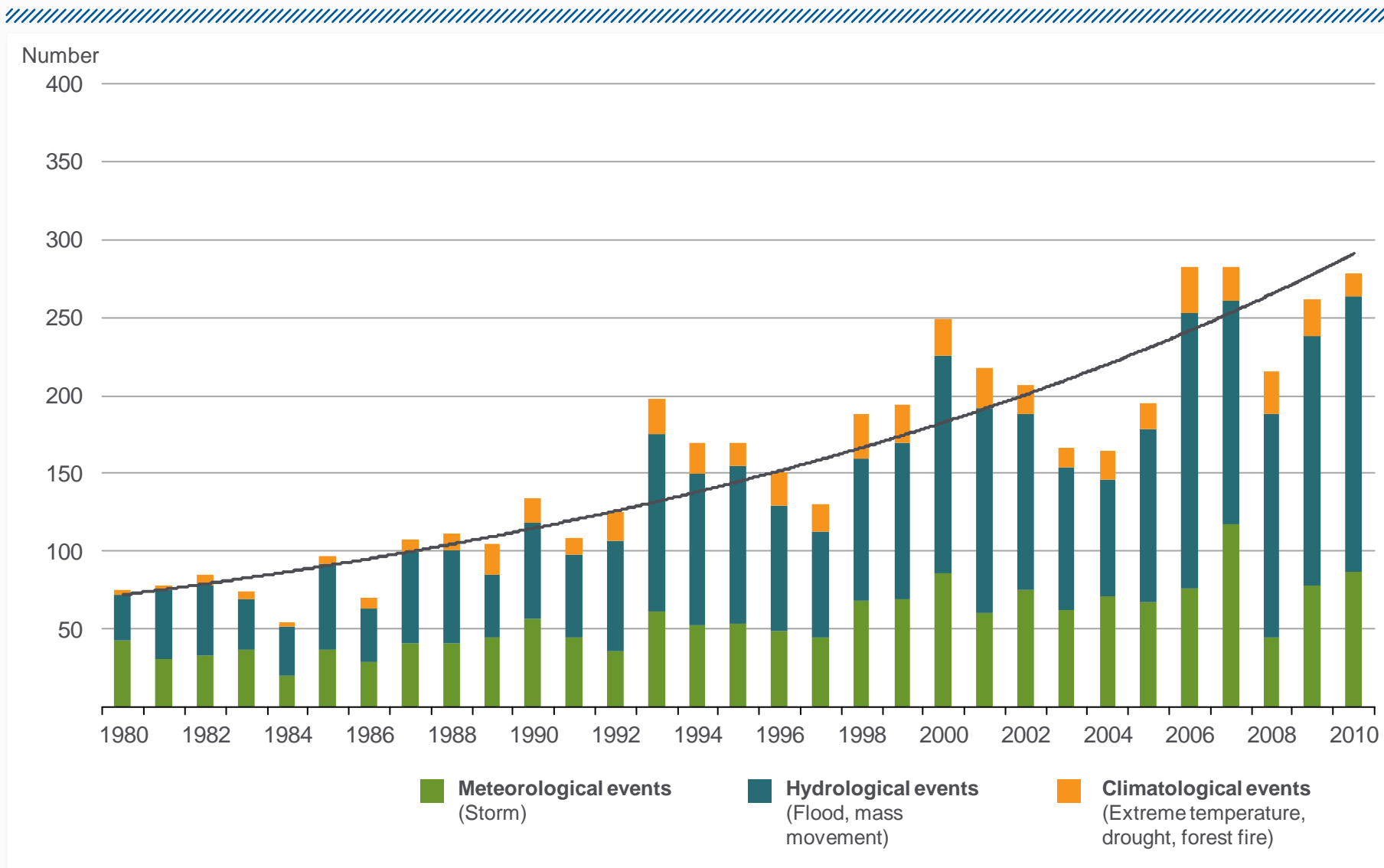
Natural catastrophes in Asia 1980 – 2010

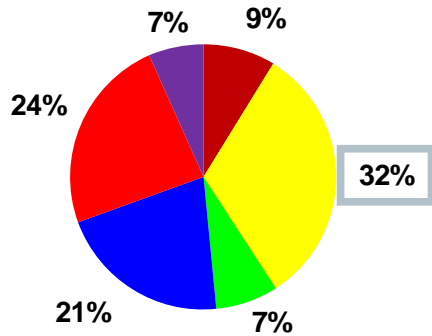

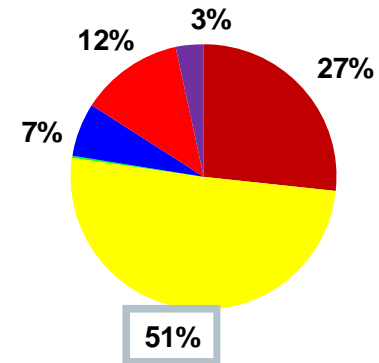
Percentage distribution – ordered by continent



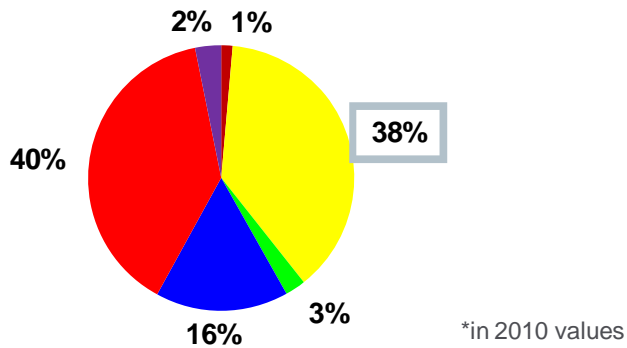

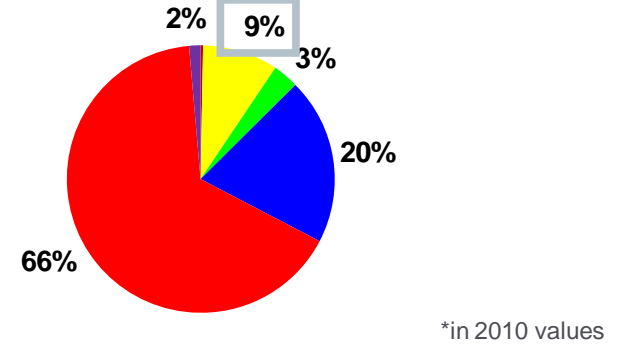

Insured losses* US\$ 740bn



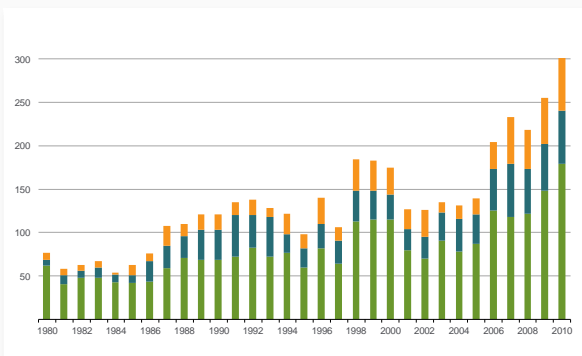

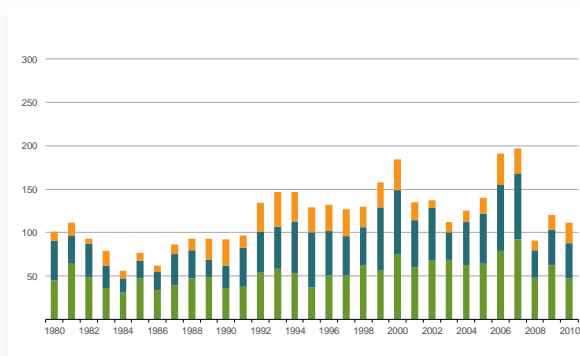
Number of weather related events per continent



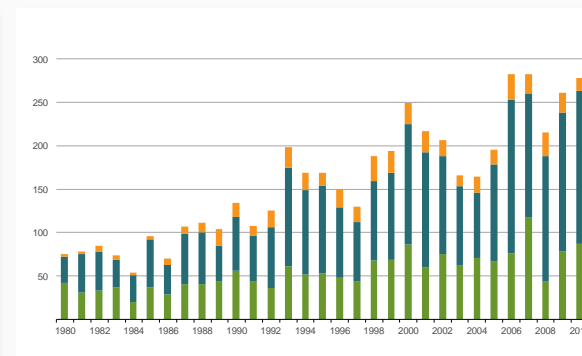
North and Central America, Caribbean (4,200)



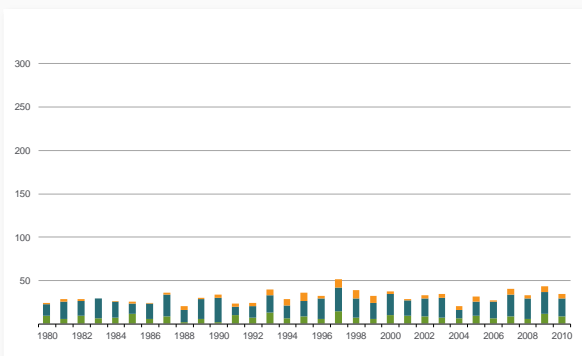
Europe (3,700)



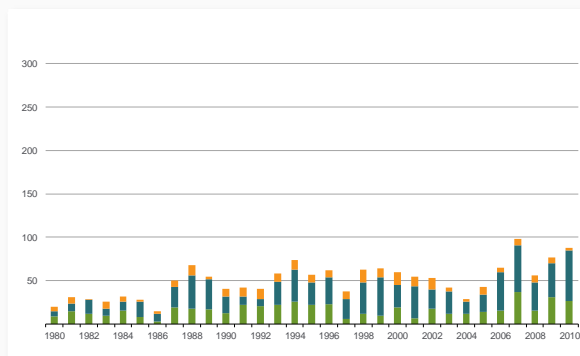
Asia (4,950)



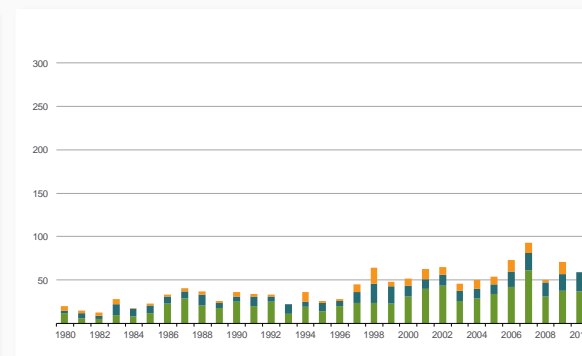
South America (975)
