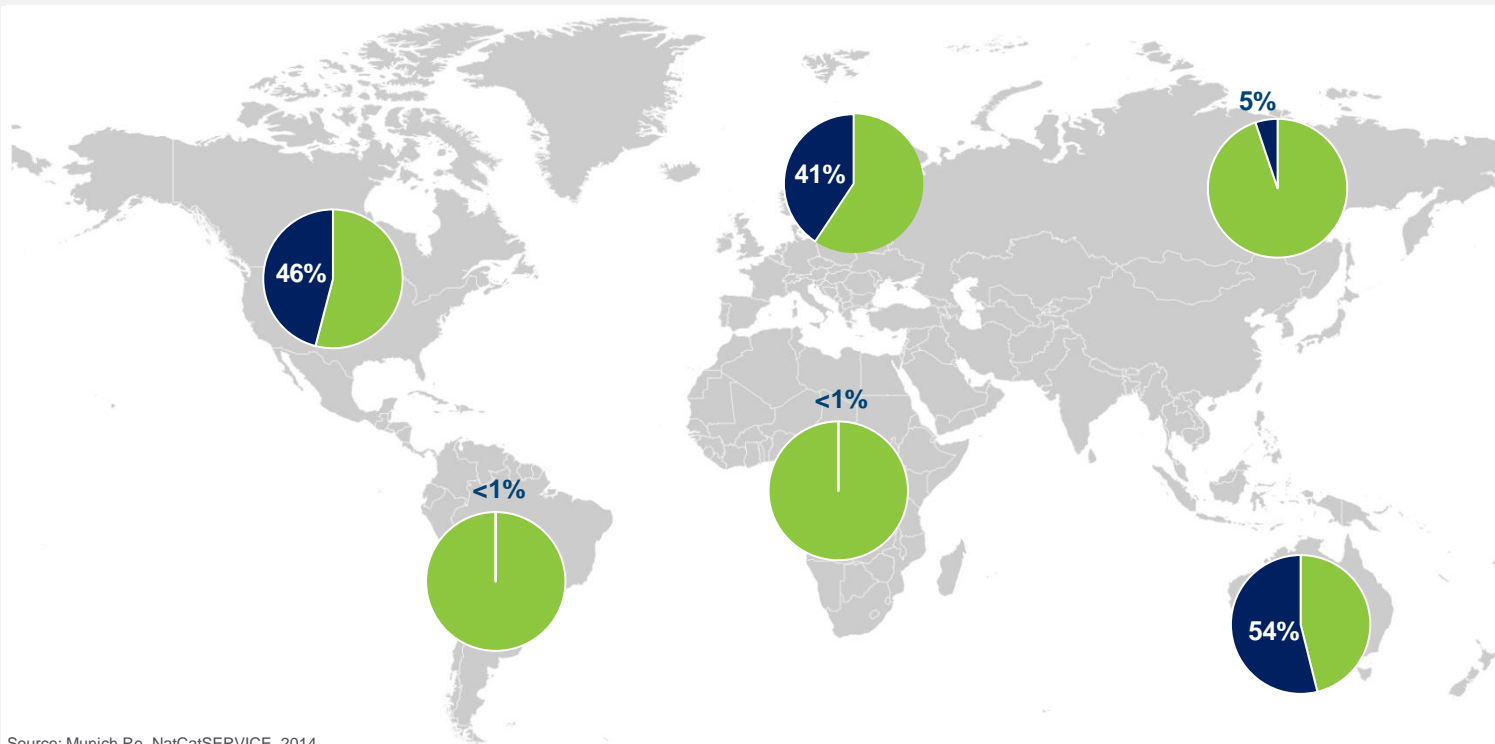

## Overall and insured losses per continent



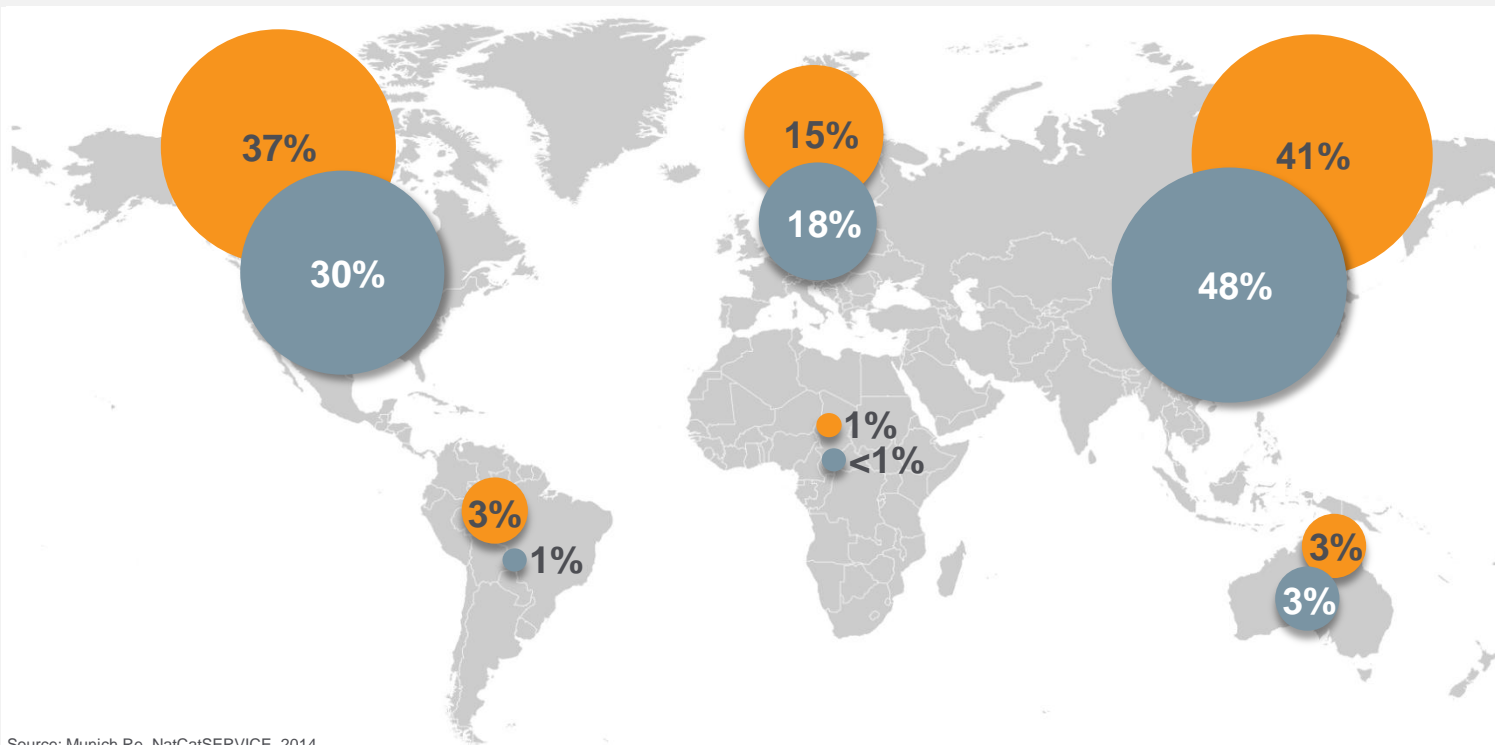

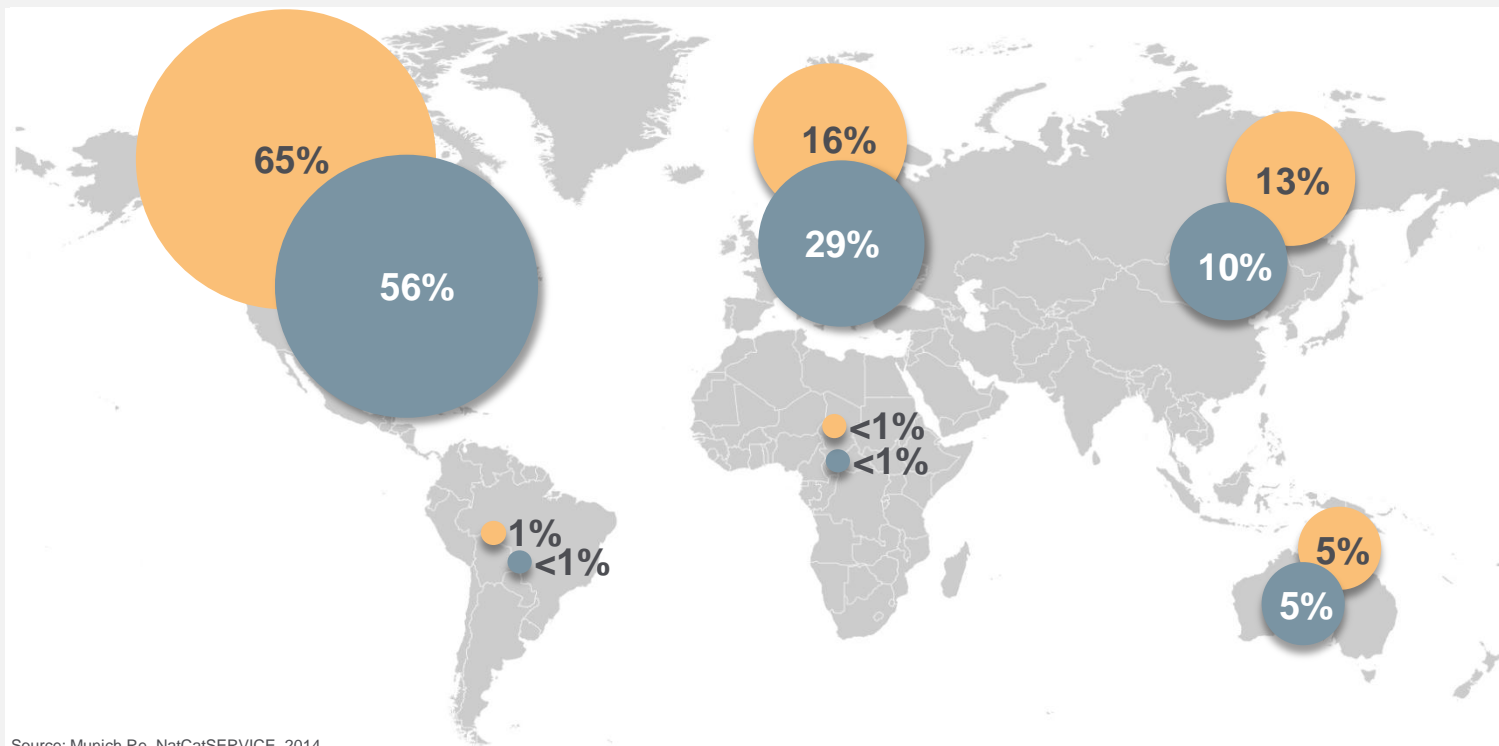
