The Regulations place duties on businesses and people who own, operate or have control over a range of work equipment; to ensure their safe use and operation.

The Noise at Work Regulations 2005*

Advice on manage employee and workplace visitor exposure to excessive noise, reducing associated potential incidents and costs (e.g. ill health).

The Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992 for workplace lighting*

Ensuring effective workplace lighting is in place for the safety of employees and visitors, reducing potential incidents and costs related to ineffective lighting provisions (e.g. accidents, ill health).

PUWER assessments

The safe use and operation of a range of work equipment is required under The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER*); critical in ensuring the safety of a business's employees and workplace visitors.

The ser vice

The scope of this service is to carry out a review of a business's work equipment safety compliance against the requirements of PUWER*.

A detailed report to be produced which will identify any compliancy shortfalls, together with any potential improvements, for any equipment which is covered by the Regulations.

The service

The scope of this service will include a full review of a business's health and safety management systems for compliance against relevant legislation and best practices to ensure all legal obligations are understood and met. This will ensure both the employer and employees are aware of their legal duties.

Workplace noise assessments

Excessive noise in the workplace can have a significant impact on employee health and wellbeing. Assessments monitoring noise levels can identify if any remedial action is required, ensuring compliance with the Noise at Work Regulations 2005*.

The service

The scope of this service is to carry out workplace noise assessments to assist in achieving compliance with the Noise at Work Regulations 2005*.

Our comprehensive report will provide details on noise levels recorded, and on safe exposure levels of measured activities. We will provide advice on viable options to reduce noise levels where required and, where relevant, provide advice on effective personal protective equipment to reduce and control employee exposure to excessive noise.

We can also help businesses to balance employee work tasks to minimise their exposure to noise by implementing a noise exposure plan.

Workplace lighting assessments

Providing and maintaining effective workplace lighting is essential in ensuring the safety of employees and visitors, as well as ensuring any tasks performed in the workplace can be carried out in a safe manner, as stipulated by The Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992*.

The service

The scope of this service is to carry out workplace lighting assessments to assist in achieving compliance with the Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992, specifically Regulation 8*. Our service comprises an onsite assessment of workplace areas where lux (a unit of illuminance) levels are measured and analysed via analytical software.

With our ability to measure a range of different lighting applications, our report will allow businesses to understand where shortfalls are present, and where improvements need to be made to maintain satisfactory lighting levels in line with the Regulations.

The benefits

- Review of current workplace lighting arrangements
- Provision of a detailed report for areas surveyed, together with relevant recommendations
- Provision of evidence that suitable lighting is being provided
- Assistance with achieving compliance with applicable legislation

Case study

HSB was engaged to carry out a survey on noise levels at a factory after the company had some concerns about the well-being of its employees in this regard.

Our survey found that noise levels were in excess of safe exposure levels stipulated by legislation. We worked closely with the business to design a new exposure plan for each task at their factory, with recommendations provided for appropriate hearing protection for each activity.
