Includes the failure of any electronic or computer equipment that controls the machinery or equipment, even if there is no physical damage. Operator error included as standard. Cover for undamaged non-compatible parts included as standard. Cover for damage whilst temporarily removed, including during transit, for the purpose of repair, service or modification. Reinstatement of machinery or equipment as new. 		
Deterioration of stock	 Cover for the deterioration of the stock resulting from a change in the temperature of a chamber, or caused by the action of refrigerant fumes that have escaped from the cold chamber. Extra cover is available for the cleaning and disinfecting of chambers; removing, disposing and replacement of deteriorated stock. 		
Loss of income	 Cover for financial loss as a result of equipment breakdown and damage or deterioration of stock, including increased costs of working. Cover also available for contractual obligations to pay direct customers and suppliers if they suffer financial loss due to an insured event.
