

Welcome to External Collaboration with Microsoft Teams

This guide will show you how you can log in to a Microsoft Team offered to you as a service by Munich Re using your company e-mail address. These instructions are intended for external guests of a Team.


Prerequisites

- A Munich Re staff member has added you to a Team as a guest using your **company e-mail address**.
- Please use a suitable current browser (e.g. Chrome or Edge).
 Other browsers (e.g. MS Internet Explorer) are not suitable.
- You also need a **telephone connection** or the **Authenticator App** for the mandatory multi-factor authentication.
- We recommend using the Authenticator app, otherwise you will have to re-authenticate at regular intervals.

Steps to follow


(both if you have or do not have an Office 365 account):

1



In your inbox you will find an email from Microsoft Teams (noreply@email.teams.microsoft.com) stating **You have been added to Munich Re in Microsoft Teams as a guest**. Open the Team from this email by clicking on **Open Microsoft Teams**.


You will be automatically redirected to the next page where you give consent to the processing of your data in order to create, control and manage an account in accordance with the policy. A new window will open automatically. Click on **Accept**.


You will now be prompted to open Microsoft Teams, which you confirm by clicking on **Open**.

The start screen of Teams is displayed and you can decide which version of Teams you want to use. For example, you can click on **Use the web app instead** to open Teams in your browser.


You will be informed that further information is required to protect your account. Please do not change the account and click **Next**.





You will now be prompted to set up MFA (multi-factor authentication) to access the Office 365 tenant at Munich Re Group. By default it is assumed that you are using the Microsoft Authenticator app, which we also recommend. If this is the case, click on **Next** in the two following windows. If you would like to use a different authentication method, click on **I want to set up a different method** (see Authentication with telephone).

The following describes the procedure with the Authenticator App by Microsoft. You can find the app in the App Store. Install this app before you continue with the registration. Scan the QR code in the login screen with the Authenticator App. Click on **Next**.


Authentication via the Authenticator app is now being tested. To do this, approve the request in your Microsoft Authenticator App on your smartphone.

You will now see a positive test result. If you want to set up another additional login method, click on the link **I want to set up another method**. Otherwise, click on **Next**.

Log in with your Microsoft account. To do this, enter your password.

In the Microsoft Authenticator app on your smartphone, authorize access.



You will then be asked to accept our Terms of Use. This completes the registration process and you can actively use the Team.


Authentication with telephone

You have carried out the previous description up to item 6 and decide to authenticate with another method. To do this, click on **I want to set up another method**.

2



Select **Phone** in the list and confirm your selection.

3



Enter the telephone number you would like to use to authenticate yourself. If you use a smartphone, you can have an SMS with a code sent to you or you can receive a call. If you use a landline telephone, please select **Call me**.

In our example, we choose ${f Call\ me}$ as Microsoft will probably discontinue the SMS function.





You will receive an automatically generated callback to the telephone number you have specified, which you have to confirm with #.

If the telephone has been registered successfully, you can continue with **Next**.





You will now see the authentication methods you selected and can complete the authentication.

You will then be asked to accept our Terms of Use. This completes the registration process and you can actively use the Team.
