


Overall and Insured Losses

Losses in 2011 (January – September): Overall = US\$ 310bn; Insured = US\$ 80bn




Natural catastrophes in Asia 1980 – 2010

Weather catastrophes in Asia 1980 – 2010




Natural catastrophes 1980-2010

Percentage distribution – ordered by continent










Weather catastrophes worldwide 1980 – 2010

Number of weather related events per continent



Caribbean (4,200)**








