

# New Ontario boiler / pressure vessel regulations come into force July 1, 2018

## Effective July 1, 2018

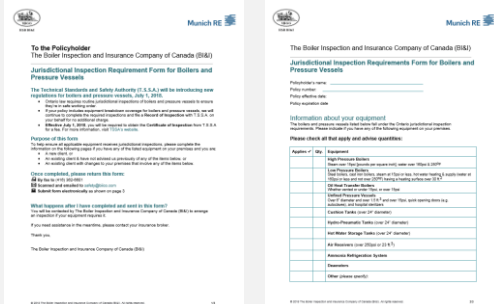
This [new regulation](#) brings Ontario in line with certification requirements of boilers and pressure vessels in other provinces

BI&I conducted inspection at no additional cost

No change

BI&I issued the Certificate of Inspection directly to owner / insured

- BI&I will provide a Record of Inspection to T.S.S.A
- BI&I inspector will provide a leave-behind document to inform owners of regulatory changes and how to obtain the Certificate of Inspection
- Owner obtains Certificate of Inspection from T.S.S.A for a fee



## Ensuring additional jurisdictional objects are identified and inspected

- BI&I's [Jurisdictional Inspection Requirement Form](#) will be distributed to the business owner with new policies and renewals
- Insured sends completed form to BI&I
- If insured is uncertain if they own jurisdictional objects, they may still request an inspection, which will be carried out at no additional cost
