This diagnostic tool helps businesses assess their cloud risks and provides security recommendations. Once shared with HSB, the report enables coverage underwriting and pricing.

Steps for Google Cloud business customers to send their report to HSB:

Get started.

The Google Cloud [Organization Administrator](#) follows Google's [onboarding documentation](#) to turn on Cyber Insurance Hub for their organization.

Create a report.

Wait 24 hours after [configuration](#), then open [Cyber Insurance Hub](#) and click [Create Manual Report](#). A report appears in seconds! (Google has YouTube tutorials on [Creating](#) and [Reviewing](#) reports.)

Send your report to HSB (via Munich Re, HSB's parent company) directly from Cyber Insurance Hub. [Google's YouTube tutorial](#) describes the remaining steps:

- **Select the report to share.** First, click the report's timestamp to be taken to report details. In the report details page, select SEND REPORT TO INSURANCE PARTNERS.
- **Share your report.** You will be brought to a new page, enabling you to easily share your report, along with some additional information about your organization ([described here](#) and in the tool).
Make sure to elect to share your report with Munich Re, HSB's parent company.
