

Data protection notice – Visitors

We would hereby like to explain how your personal data will be processed by Munich Reinsurance Company, and inform you of your rights under data protection law.

What kinds of data do we process, for what purposes, and on what legal grounds?

We will process your personal data in compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG), and all other applicable national laws.

We need your contact data (your name and potentially your company and country) to manage your visit, and to protect our legitimate interests in our property (Art. 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, Section 4 of the BDSG) using the necessary security standards.

We may also record your data through video surveillance at certain buildings, such as in front of the visitors’ entrances, or at the entrances to the parking garages or parking lots.

Who provides us with your data?

Your personal data will be collected either directly from you, here at the reception, or entered into our administration system beforehand by your contact person with us.

How long will we store your data and who has access to it?

We will delete your personal data as soon as it is no longer required for the purposes set out above, latest after three months.

What data protection rights do you have?

In addition to your right to object, you have a right to information, a right to have your data erased under certain conditions, as well as a right to restrict processing. Please contact the aforementioned address to exercise these rights.

Right to object:
If we process your data for the purposes of protecting legitimate interests, you may object to this processing on grounds relating to your particular situation. We will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing that override your interests, rights and freedoms, or if the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Would you like to file a complaint about how your data is being handled?
